It was a good weekend with some fantastic games taking place. Ben Duffy won the Open Men's singles against Otago Junior Isaac Hobbs. This was Ben's 10th Southland Open individual title. This equals the record held by former Southlander John Catto.

Maia Cavanagh won the Open Women's singles against Gemma Buzzard in four sets. She also won the Open Women's doubles with Gemma and the Mixed Doubles with Isaac Hobbs against Gemma and Ben in a very exciting mixed doubles final.

Willie Brocks (Southland) and Edwin Nieman (Otago) won the O21, O30 and O45 double titles going through the tournament in doubles unbeaten.

Willie Brocks also won all three singles titles in the above age groups with Edwin coming in at 2nd place. Kelly Martin won the O60 singles in a close fought match against Barry Ellis who finished 2nd.

James Catto (Bay of Plenty) beat Maia Cavanagh to take out the title in the U21 singles. Isaac Hobbs won the U19 singles title against Kevin Tang (Otago).

In the U15 and U13 singles the brother-sister duo of William and Tracey Hsia took out the 1st and 2nd place over both events.

In the second grade singles Cameron Singh (Otago) beat Neill William (Central Otago), Abigail Bottger (Southland) beat Ella Woodward (Otago).

In the second grade doubles Southland's Mark Moore and Keegan Jackson beat Karoly Erdelyi and Mike Morus.
