Star player Willie Brocks went through the season unbeaten winning all 14 games. He was ably supported by Karoly Erderli and Mike Morus who played a good part in their title win. Andrew Fleming was second in the averages winning 68.4% of his games with Gemma Buzzard from Eagles 1 coming in at third place with 64.3%.

#### **B** Grade

The vastly improving Eagles 4 team of Megan Parkinson and Yulia Shalina took out the B Grade title. They beat the second placed IWMC 2 team on the night by 3 matches to 2.
